I hope you are keeping safe and warm in this chilly weather! Despite COVID restrictions and the wild weather recently, the term has been running smoothly, and it's been wonderful to see the return of sport!

We are updating our COVID ready plan just in case there are more restrictions put in place or we have a site closure. If we have to close (fingers crossed we won't!) we need to be able to contact families within an hour and students will need to be picked up from school immediately. Please ensure you are connected to ClassDojo as this is the first communication tool that will be used. Contact your child's class teacher if you need help with this.

Thank you for maintaining 1.5m at drop off and pick up. Please remember that once you have dropped off or collected your child that you need to leave the school grounds promptly. We highly recommend that you don't drop off your child before 8.45am unless absolutely necessary eg work commitments (even though there is a teacher on yard duty at 8.30am) as children must wait patiently outside their classroom – the longer they have to wait, the harder it is, especially for some of our young ones. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

As we cannot do physical school tours for prospective parents at the moment, we have created a short video which is on our website, showcasing our school and students – we think it's great! If you have a child due to start school next year or know of anyone else please contact the front office to organise an enrolment interview.

Support staff week 24-28 Sept

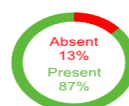

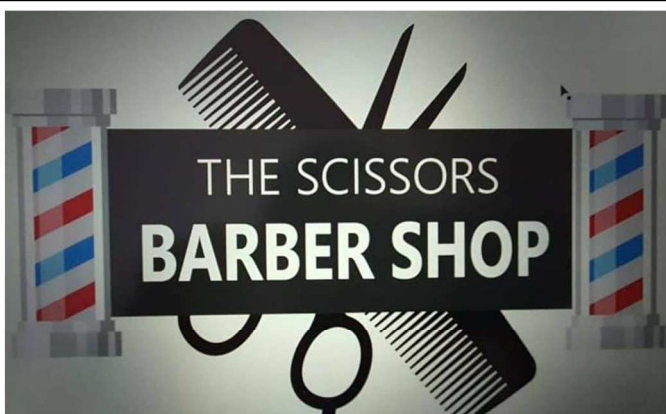
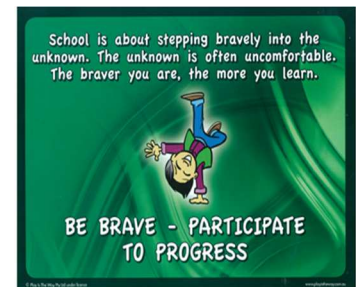

Payment

- Uniform items ordered through the app will be delivered to the student's classroom on Monday and Wednesday mornings. If the size ordered appears to be incorrect, Janine will swap it for the right size.
- Cash will be accepted at the uniform shop but please have the correct change. Parents and students can collect the item then and there.
- Payments by EFTPOS can be made at the front office. Parents must take the receipt to the uniform shop where Janine will be happy to look after you!
